Peninsula-Area High School Students Gather Virtually to “Break the Cycle” of Prejudice at 11th Annual Diversity Dialogue Day

What: Peninsula Diversity Dialogue Day

When: Wednesday, January 20 & Thursday, January 21, 2021, from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm.

Where: Online

Who: Nearly 80 high school students and educators from 11 public and private schools in Hampton, Newport News, Williamsburg-James City County, and Poquoson will participate in discussions and activities around diversity, discrimination, and respect. Diversity Dialogue Day is conducted by the Virginia Center for Inclusive Communities with support from Dominion Energy.

How: Students will view “Break the Cycle: Be the Change,” a presentation that examines the concept of prejudice. They will then meet in intentionally diverse breakout groups to build connections, learn from peers their age, and develop strategies to stand up to prejudice within their schools.
