Peninsula-Area High School Students Gather Virtually to "Break the Cycle" of Prejudice at 12th Annual Diversity Dialogue Day

What: 12th Annual Peninsula Diversity Dialogue Day

When: Thursday, November 11, 2021 from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Where: Online

Who: Approximately 70 high school students and educators from Peninsula-area public and private high schools in Gloucester, Hampton, Newport News, and Poquoson will participate in discussions and activities around diversity, discrimination, and respect.

How: Students will view "Break the Cycle: Be the Change," a presentation that examines the concept of prejudice. They will then meet in intentionally diverse breakout groups to build connections, learn from peers their age, and develop strategies to stand up to prejudice within their schools.
